II. <u>BY EXAMINING OURSELVES AND JUDGING</u> WHAT WE FIND WRONG IN OUR LIVES (I Cor. 11:28,31,32)

- 1. We can put away sin in our lives
- 2. We can eat in a worthily manner

III. BY EATING AND DRINKING IN REMEMBRANCE OF OUR LORD'S DEATH (I Cor. 11:24,25)

- 1. It was His death that saved us (Heb. 9:22)
- 2. It was His death that we reflect upon.
